2. Reason for the Revision

Based on management conditions throughout the fiscal period ended December 31, 2010 and a review of its distributions-per-unit forecast, MID REIT anticipates that its actual distribution per unit for the fiscal period ended December 31, 2010 will differ by more than 5% from the previous forecast announced on August 16, 2010. Such difference is primarily attributable to repair and maintenance as well as interest expenses expected to be lower than initially anticipated, although utility expenses of existing properties will exceed anticipated figures.

1. The aforementioned forecasts are current as of the date of this release. Accordingly, actual distributions per unit are subject to change. On this basis, MID REIT does not guarantee payment of the forecast distribution per unit.
